

We believe that all Scripture (the Old Testament in the Hebrew and Aramaic and the New Testament in the Greek) is inspired by God ("God breathed," 2 Tim. 3:16), and is without error or contradiction. The Holy Spirit guided the writers to write the very words of God (2 Pet. 1:19-21, 1 Cor. 2:13, Matt. 5:18, John 17:17), yet the writers were not merely stenographers, but wrote in accordance with their individual talents, abilities and character even as the Holy Spirit directed them. The focus of the Bible is Jesus Christ; the Bible informs us concerning Him and leads us to Him (Luke 24:27, 44, John 5:39, Acts 17:2-3). Finally, all Scripture is "profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work" (2 Tim. 3:16-17, cf. Luke 24:27, Rom. 15:4, 1 Cor. 10:11).
